	<p>As He was being questioned by Pilate, Jesus said, “My kingdom is not of this world” (John 18:36). By saying this, Jesus made a clear distinction between the world and His kingdom. Previously we learned that God loves the whole world but that doesn’t mean that God saves the whole world. Thus, Jesus’ statement reveals the distinction between the world and the saved because Jesus clearly taught that the world is not automatically placed in the kingdom but people have to choose to enter it (Matthew 5:20; 7:21; 18:3; Mark 9:47; John 3:5).</p>
